We looked at numerous venues across the UK and have chosen Stirling University for its versatility, wide range of accommodation options and access to 3 International airports, all within one hour's travel. Stirling is just one hour by car from Glasgow and Prestwick in the West and Edinburgh in the East. Stirling University is located in a beautiful and historic part of Scotland, surrounded by lots of open space and is not far from Loch Lomond and the Trossachs. Stirling Castle and the Wallace Monument stand proudly over the town. We have chosen the venue not only for its wide range of accommodation options but also for its extensive choice of Conference Rooms, Lecture Theatres etc. It has an Arts Theatre, Cinema, Shops, Bank, Pharmacy, Cafes, Restaurant, Bars, Lochside Walks, Swimming Pool, Fitness Gym, 9 hole Golf Course and much more.

Conference Registration

Please answer all the questions you are asked, as it helps us with our planning. Places are limited so please book as soon as possible to avoid disappointment. You are advised to take out Travel Insurance prior to booking to cover any unforeseen events.**

As a **Resident**, on Campus, your full Weekend Registration includes your attendance at the conference on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, and includes lunch and refreshments on these days. Tickets are available Adult - £170, Child 3 - 12 years - £110, 0-3 years, free of charge.

Non Resident, off Campus, Daily Registration includes your attendance at the conference on a daily basis on Friday, or Saturday or Sunday or all three days and includes lunch and refreshments on these days. Tickets are available per day, Adult - £70, Child 3 - 12 years £40, 0-3 years, free of charge.

Optional extras

Kids Club is for children aged 0-12 years, where the children will be looked after on-site, while parents attend the various talks and workshops. We are providing a crèche with an appropriate number of fully trained and experienced staff available, who will ensure the children have a fun-filled day. There will be games, crafts, colouring, music, stories and much more. The children will join their parents for lunch and return to the Kids Club in the afternoon. There will be an opportunity for the children to perform in the show on Saturday evening if they want to. Rehearsals will take place during Kids Club. This is a club that we run every year at our National Conference and the children have a great time and make new friends. **Kids Club 0-12 years - £40 per day**

Teens Club is for teens with TS, siblings, and friends who are 12 years old and over. We recommend that all teens are fully knowledgeable about their TS as we cannot control conversation content. Ice breakers and show rehearsals begin on Friday morning with Sam (also known as Mama Cubitt) and her daughter Daisy, who helps plan the show. This is where initial friendship bonds are made, and Teens are usually inseparable from here on! There will be music, dance, and singing, with time to talk and share. We have wonderful teen co-ordinators and reps that will help Sam and ensure a great time is had by all. There will also be optional workshops for the teens to attend. This is a club that we run every year at our National Conference, the teens have a great time and make new friends. **Teen Club 12 years plus- £30 per day**
